THE SEVEN ARROGANCES

FIRST CHAKRA — THE ARROGANCE OF AMBITION

The Arrogance of Ambition causes initiates to race ahead out of the desire to succeed, which can result in skipping or missing steps in the initiation process. As this arrogance is released, you learn to retain at whatever pace the body and spirit can most easily flow at while maintaining your centeredness and harmony. This arrogance is related to the Kumara of Fear, and it is the vibration of Divine Union that transmutes this arrogance.

SECOND CHAKRA — THE ARROGANCE OF INFLEXIBILITY

The Arrogance of Inflexibility causes initiates to retain patterns rather than releasing them out of the fear of change. As this arrogance is released, you learn to release everything at whatever pace the body and spirit can comfortably handle. This arrogance is related to the Kumara of Lust, and it is the vibration of Honor that transmutes this arrogance.

THIRD CHAKRA — THE ARROGANCE OF ABUSIVE POWER

The Arrogance of Abusive Power causes initiates to either allow abusive energy unconsciously through their fields in order to control/manipulate others or control the abusive energy within the field of another. As this arrogance is released, you learn to allow all beings their lesson and

experience without interference. This arrogance is related to the Kumara of Pain, and it is the vibration of Peace that transmutes this arrogance.

FOURTH CHAKRA — THE ARROGANCE OF CODEPENDENT LOVE

The Arrogance of Codependent Love causes initiates to retain relationships that do not support their spiritual journey. As this arrogance is released, you learn to draw only others who resonate with the path of ascension into your circle. This can apply to your guidance as well as those you know on the physical plane. This arrogance is related to the Kumara of Judgment, and it is the vibration of Forgiveness that transmutes this arrogance.

FIFTH CHAKRA — THE ARROGANCE OF HOARDING

The Arrogance of Hoarding causes initiates to either hoard their possessions, thus not releasing their attachment to the third-dimensional world, or impoverish themselves by believing that poverty is a part of the spiritual path. As this arrogance is released, giving and receiving come to balance within and initiates experience true abundance. This arrogance is related to the Kumara of Greed, and it is the vibration of Abundance that transmutes this arrogance.

SIXTH CHAKRA — THE ARROGANCE OF SEEING IT ALL

The Arrogance of Seeing it All causes initiates to believe they see the whole picture and, in so doing, stop looking deeper or at other potential patterns they have yet to release. As this

arrogance is released, you learn that you never see as much as the soul and that the soul never sees as much as God/Goddess/All That Is. In understanding this, you learn to be humble and take direction from what sees more than yourself. This arrogance is related to the Kumara of Suffering, and it is the vibration of Harmony that transmutes this arrogance.

SEVENTH CHAKRA — THE ARROGANCE OF KNOWING IT ALL

The Arrogance of Knowing it All causes initiates either to believe that they know everything (and in this they stop evolving) or believe that all knowledge is outside of themselves (thereby they are forever looking elsewhere for their truth). As this arrogance is transcended, you learn that your truth comes from within and to be humble in the understanding that the soul and God/Goddess/All That Is will always know more than yourself. This arrogance is related to the Kumara of Death. It is the vibration of Compassion that transcends this arrogance.
